Leadership styles



- Autocratic or authoritarian style
- Participative or democratic style
- Laissez –Faire or free rein style

Autocratic Leadership Style



Under the autocratic leadership style, all decision-making powers are centralized in the leader , as with dictator leaders. They do not entertain any suggestions or initiatives from subordinates.

Participative or democratic style



The democratic leadership style favors decision-making by the group . They can win the cooperation of their group and can motivate them effectively and positively. The decisions of the democratic leader are not unilateral as with the autocrat because they arise from consultation with the group members and participation by them

Laissez –Faire or free rein style



A free rein leader does not lead, but leaves the group entirely to itself such a leader allows maximum freedom to subordinates , i.e. they are given a free hand in deciding their own policies and methods.
