Webinar began with welcome note by Smt. Bhramaramba, event coordinator and Assistant Professor of Business Administration. 96 students participated in the webinar.


Prof. Umesha, principal gave inaugural address. In his address he highlighted the basic concept of stock market and recent practice of trading on stock market offline and well on online.


Webinar was ended with question and answers session.14 students asked questions by raised their hands and obtained answer.




A DAY WEBINAR ON "HOW TO SUCEED COMPITATIVE EXAMS"?



The progrmme co-ordinator and librarian mastered the programme with welcome note at the beginning and thanking note at the end.












PRINCIPALS MEETING HOSTED BY JSS MVP








PRINCIPALS MEETING HOSTED BY DCE


PARENT VIRTUAL MEETING






SUBMISSION OF IIQA



WEBINAR ON PGCET



Dr. M R Ravi, District Magistrate and Deputy Commissioner of Chamarajnagar District delivered key note address and witnessed the institutional award event.












E - CONTENT DEVELOPMENT
