

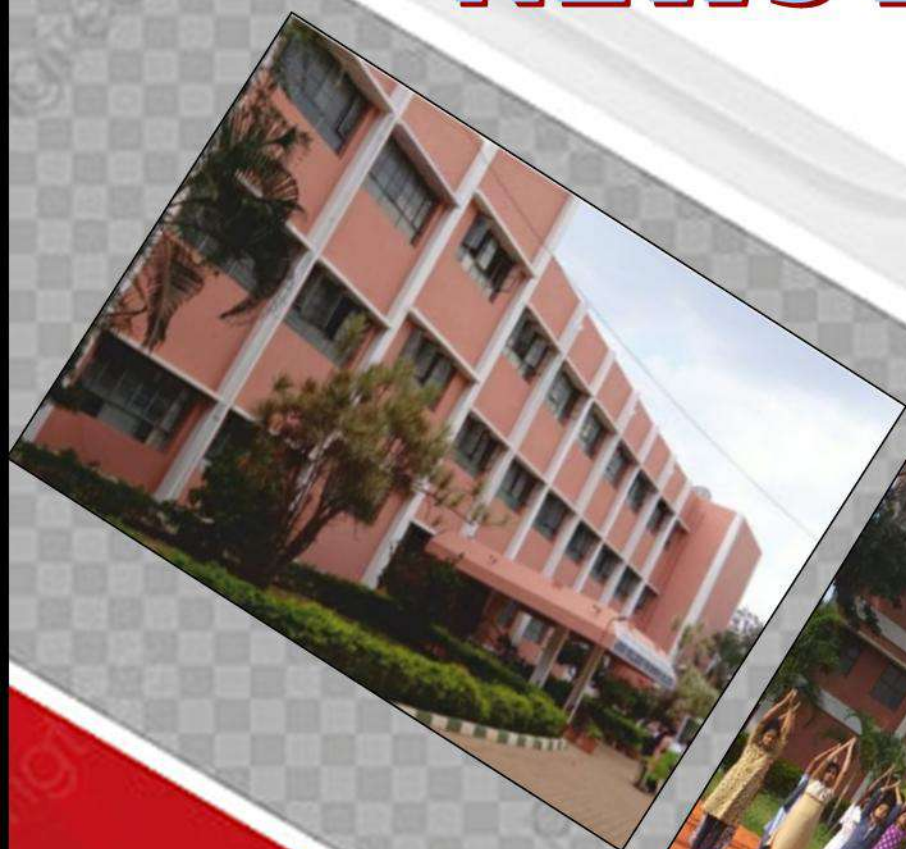

KARNATAKA RAJYOTSAVA DAY

“Kannada Language has an unbroken literacy history of over a thousand years and with over 38 million speakers, it is one of the 40 most spoken languages in the world”.

“The criteria for the formation of the Indian states are language. India became republic in the year 1950. In same year linguistic provinces were formed and Mysore State was one such state in South India”. “On 1 November 1973 it was changed Karnataka state. Late Devaraj Urs the then Chief Minister, Mysore State took this landmark decision”.

Since then every year on 1 November in Karnataka Rajyotsava Day is a colourful celebration with the red and yellow of the state flag being displayed across Karnataka.

POCSO ACT AWARENESS PROGRAMME

The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, [POCSO] 2012 strengthens the legal provisions for the protection of children from sexual abuse and exploitation. It protects all children under the age of 18 years from the offences of sexual harassment and pornography. The IPC does not differentiate between adult and child victims whereas the POCSO Act penalizes sexual offences committed against children.

It is essential that school management and staff understand their roles and responsibility well in reference to the basic provisions under the POCSO Act, 2012 to comply with its provisions.

With this objective and to spread awareness about this Act and its latest amendments on awareness programme held on 9 November 2021 in the college auditorium between 11.00 am and 1.00 pm in association with Legal Awareness Cell and Advocates Association of Kollegal. Programme was initiated by Women Sexual Harassment Prevention Cell, Alumni Association & YRC units.

Event began with an invocation by art student. Smt. Smitha A S welcomed dignitaries and students. Honorable Civil Judge, Sri Anand inaugurated the programme by lighting the lamp. In his address he focused on the need of its wide publicity among children and young generation.

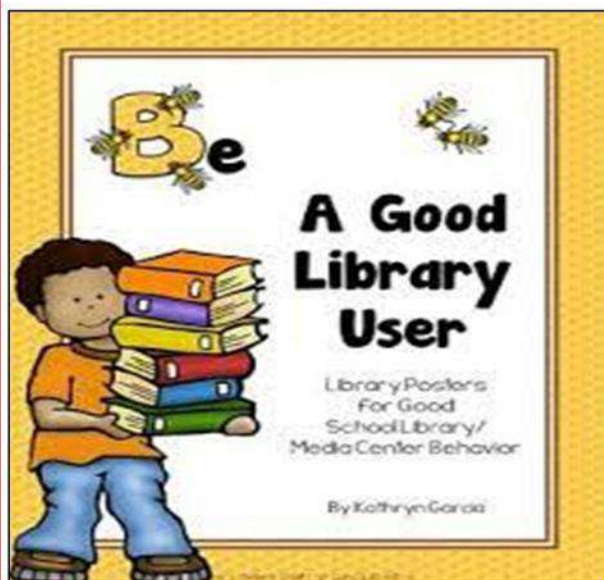

SEP ON E-RESOURCES AND ITS ACCESSIBILITY

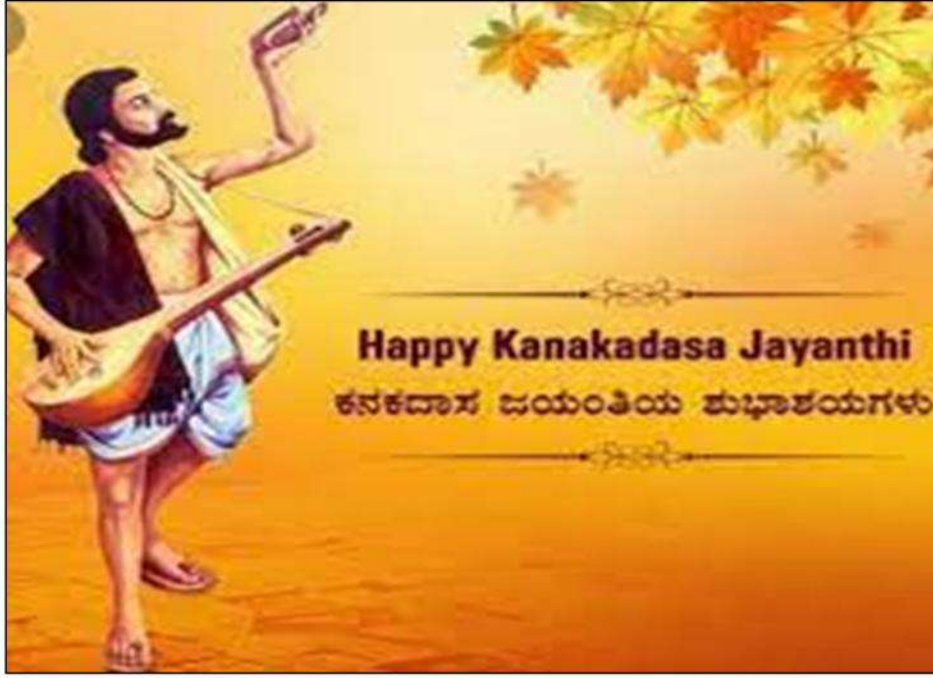
