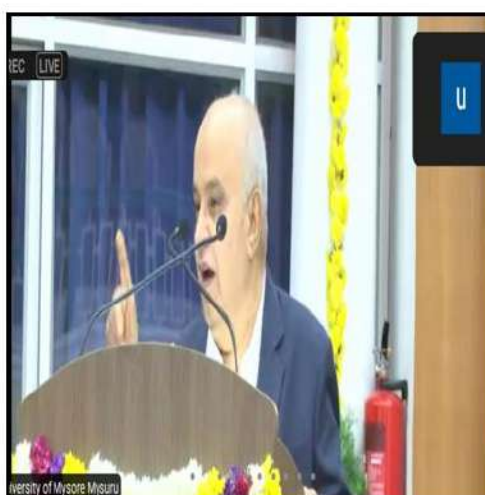


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LIVE STREAMING OF A DAY WORKSHOP

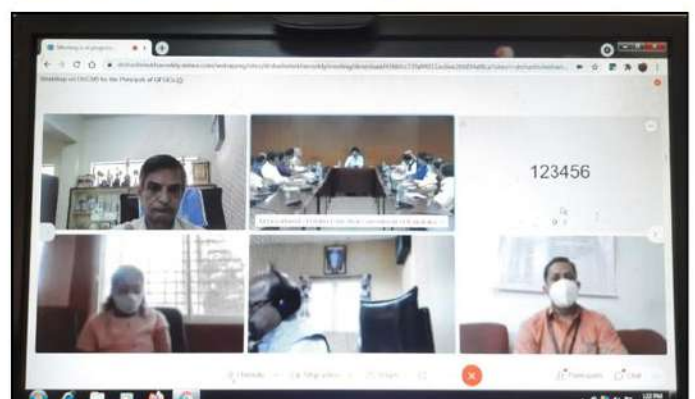
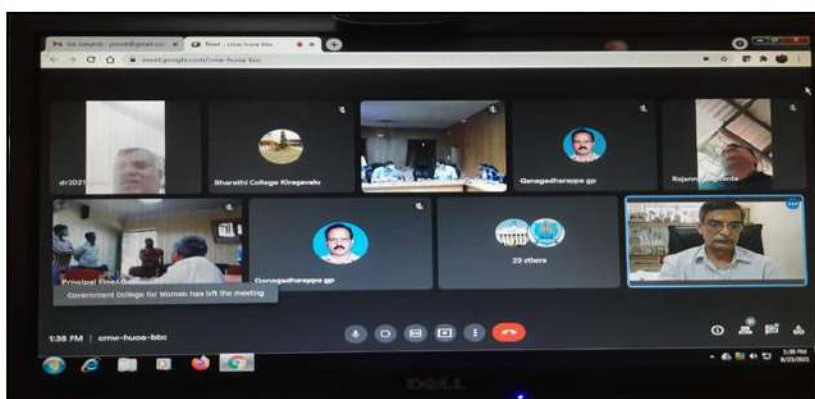
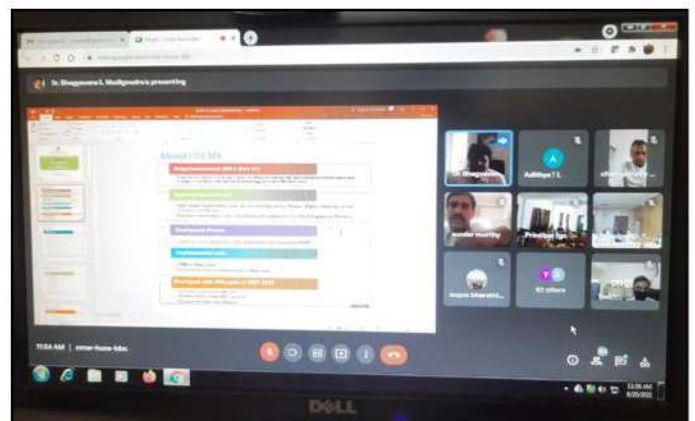
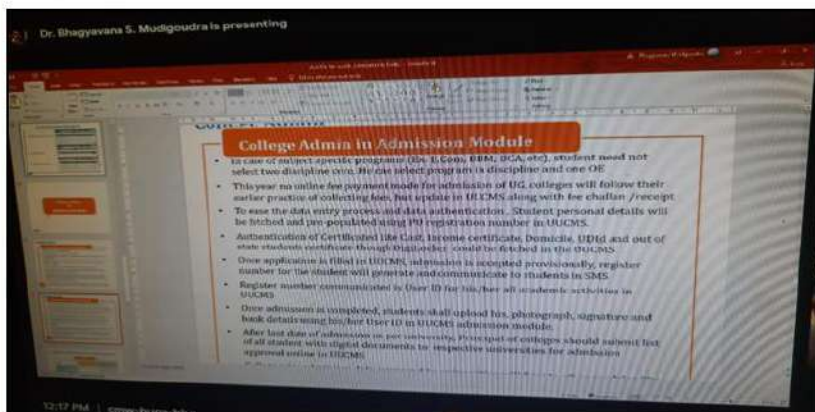
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LIVE STREAMING OF LAUNCHING PROGRAMME OF UUCMS
