LIVE STREAMING OF UNION BUDGET - 2022

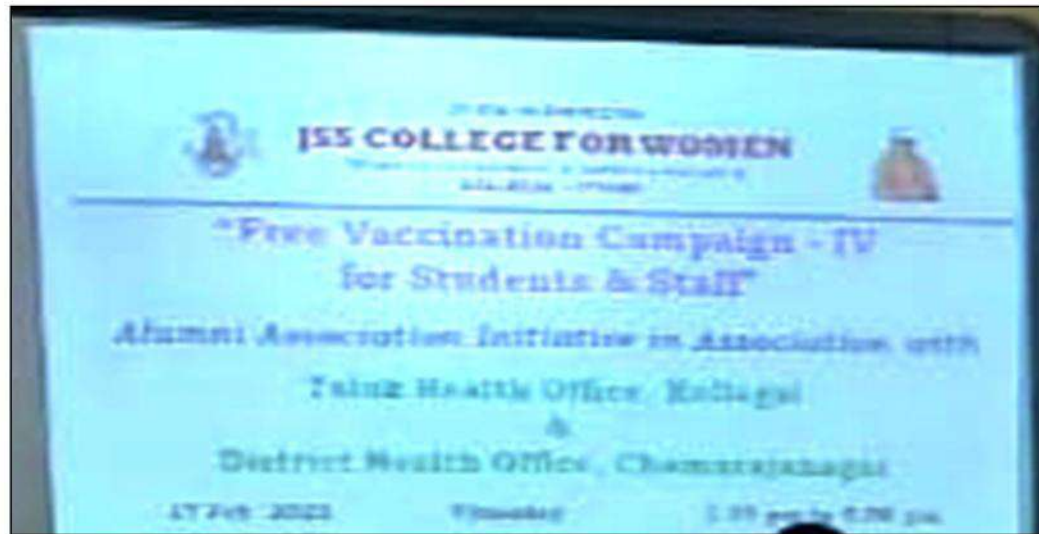


FREE VACCINATION CAMPAIGN - IV
